John Singer Sargent, a masterful nineteenthcentury artist, is celebrated for his Grand Manner portraiture of the European and American elite. Jane Oneail will join us virtually on Thursday, April 21 at 6:00 p.m. on Zoom, to talk to us about this incredible artist. Jane will explore his most beloved, as well as rarely seen images, including portraits, forays into Impressionism, and stunning watercolors.

Jane Oneail is an independent scholar and holds a master's degree in art history from Boston University and a master's degree in art in education from Harvard University. Jane is a New Hampshire native and has worked at some of the state's most

**Chunky Hand Knit Throw**

Attendees need to bring their own yarn, four skeins of Chenille Chunky (Super Bulky 6) Yarn (31.7 yards/8 oz.) like the Mainstays brand sold at WalMart, or four

skeins of Bernat Blanket Big Yarn (32 yards/10.6 oz.) sold at Michaels. Space is very limited.
