BORROW, RENEW, REQUEST

Library items can be checked out for 14 days. Items returned late do not accrue fines (exceptions listed below). Nesmith Library items will auto renew up to 3 times, as long as no other patron is waiting on hold for that item.

- Overdue fines still apply to:
 - Interlibrary loan items (varies)
 - Too Hot to Hold: 7 day loan period, no holds or renewals.
 \$0.25/day overdue fine.
 - Unusual Items, \$1/day
